

David Graham, 38, Phila. HEW official

Memorial services will be held today for David Graham, 38, an official in the Philadelphia regional offices of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare (HEW). He was killed when his car collided with a truck Friday evening near Chestertown, Md.

Mr. Graham, staff liaison to the Federal Regional Council, previously had been regional rural affairs coordinator. He joined HEW in 1971 as coordinator for state child development programs in Alabama, Ohio and New York.

A native of Philadelphia, Mr. Graham attended Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa. He received a master's degree and completed the course

work for a doctorate in psychology at Temple.

Before joining HEW, he worked as a research assistant at Temple and as a psychology intern at the Philadelphia Psychiatric Center. He was a certified clinical psychologist with specialties in the fields of psychodiagnosis and psychotherapy.

Mr. Graham lived at 2013 Corinthian Ave., Abington.

He is survived by his wife, Mary; three children, Laura, Matthew and Todd; his parents and three sisters.

Memorial services will be held at 1:30 p.m. today at the Craft Funeral Home, Old York and Old Welsh Roads, Abington. Burial will be at Westminster Cemetery, Bala Cynwyd.
